# Dell Battery Recall

Dell has identified a potential issue associated with certain Dell-branded batteries manufactured by Sony and sold with Dell Latitude™, Inspiron™, XPS™ and Dell Precision Mobile Workstation™ notebook computers between April 1, 2004 and July 18, 2006; and has voluntarily issued a recall. Potentially affected batteries were sold with the following models of Dell notebook computers or provided or sold separately as secondary batteries:

- Latitude: D410, D500, D505, D510, D520, D600, D610, D620, D800, D810;
- Inspiron: 6000, 8500, 8600, 9100, 9200, 9300, 500m, 510m, 600m, 6400, E1505, 700m, 710m, 9400, E1705;
- Dell Precision Mobile Workstations: M20, M60, M70 and M90; and
- XPS: XPS, XPS Gen2, XPS M170, and XPS M1710.

The words “Dell and one of the following are printed on the batteries: “Made in Japan”, or “Made in China”, or “Battery Cell Made in Japan Assembled in China”. Immediately discontinue use of the battery and use the AC adapter and power cord to power your system until your replacement battery is received.

Dell will provide a means for you to return the affected batteries for proper disposal.
